Opening the Doors

On the lovely evening of the Thai celebration of Loy Krathong the 12th of November, the Swedish Ambassador to Thailand H.E. Mr. Lennart Linnér and his wife Marie opened the doors to their beautiful private residence in Bangkok.

The main reason for having the event was the newly opening of the first Swedish Trade Council office in Bangkok, run by Head of Office Hakan Nylander and Ongarch Phatanachinda. The guests were a mix of 80-100 people, mainly Swedes, related to Swedish business in Asia. A special guest was joining all the way from Sweden, Ulf Berg, President and CEO of the Swedish Trade Council. In the welcome speech held by the Ambassador H.E. Mr. Lennart Linnér, he started up by explaining why Thailand is so important back home.

"Thailand is the number one tourist destination for Sweden, including Europe," the Ambassador said.

He told how pleased he was that the President was joining the night's event and emphasized how important it is for the Swedish business to work together, including the Swedish Embassy and the Swedish Trade Council.

"If we can combine our forces we can do well," the Ambassador explained and added that it especially has become necessary to collaborate doing the economical crisis which has also hit Thailand.

"It requires patience but we are here for the long haul and we have a terrific collaboration with the Swedish council," Mr. Lennart Linnér explained.

Also Ulf Berg, President and CEO of the Swedish Trade Council said a few welcoming words and told how important it is for Sweden to grow international and also use Thailand for outsourcing Swedish business.

"I think we can do much more now we are here. I really hope we can do even more business together," he said.

Then he finished by thanking the Ambassador and his wife Marie for hosting the event and declared the new Trade Council office in Bangkok for open.
